Here's a remember of the Bible Verse that was the focus of our first Early Morning Prayers back in the New Year - Isaiah ch43, v18 and part of 19. And although it may ask from us more than we even knew we had, its reward is to show us things that we never even knew we would be privileged enough to see. GOD IS GOOD!

If you're thinking "why am I reading this after everything that's happened?", speak to a Member of the Leadership Team to get your answer – failing that, come & Worship with us, because the only people that could be asking that question are

ones who haven't worshipped with us since we had to move, and so haven't seen just exactly how God has turned a tragedy into a triumph.
