We're streaming the Christian Conference called SPRING HARVEST again – although a little scaled-down to previous years, 'cuz it isn't as easy when we're not in our own building! Hopefully it'll work – we'll update you as we need to, but, for now, plan on it happening! We'll be streaming two aspects – Bible Teaching in the morning, and Worship

Celebration in the evening – we'd love to do more, but this is what's best whilst we're out of our own building. We'll be doing it in two ways – the Morning Session of Bible Teaching will be streamed over 'Zoom', and the



evening Worship Celebration will be done at St. Luke's School. So, for the morning, you'll get a ZOOM INVITE, you'll log-on to that, then we'll all watch it that way – the Evening Session is at a later time this year, it doesn't start 'til 8:30pm. We suggest that you arrive from 8pm onwards, ready for the Celebration to start at 8:30pm – we don't know what time it will finish, but we suspect it'll be around 10pm. We'll know more after the first one of each Session, how they run and how long for, and if it'll actually all work – but we don't want you to be put off, we want as many of us to join together as possible, and for both Sessions, so please try your best to join with us, it'll be great! It runs from the evening of Monday the 14th of April, and finishes on the morning of Friday the 18th of April, Good Friday – if you've got any questions, ask us! We're not sure if it'll work in the School Hall, due to the restrictions that they have on their Internet – we'll confirm on Sunday the 13th of April, so that you know what to do on Monday the 14th when it starts!
